In the spirit of reflecting on the year and showing gratitude, write a thank you letter or an email to your favourite author or illustrator.




Create a Christmas themed drink to enjoy while reading a Christmas book. It might even be inspired by a favourite book!





Turn on some Christmas lights and read surrounded by the sparkling light. You might be able to enjoy this experience outside at night – under a tree or perhaps on a trampoline.




___ Watch a Christmas movie based on a book. Some ideas: How The Grinch Stole Christmas, The Polar Express, A Christmas Carol.

Make some book themed decorations for your Christmas tree.






Create a miniature scene inspired by a Christmas book.




